TEST DESCRIPTION AND INSTRUCTIONS:

Kolbe Academy's Latin Assessment Test is designed to aid parents/students in selecting which level of Latin in which to enroll. This test is intended to provide some basic data regarding the student's grammar knowledge by degrees: mastery, much experience, some experience, no experience and is based on First-Fourth Form Latin books. Part One of the corresponds to First Form, Part Two to Second Form, and Part Three to Third Form. The test only considers grammar forms, not vocabulary.

Mastery, in this test, is 80% or higher. This assumes that the student would merely need to conduct a brief review of grammar material and vocabulary before moving on to the next level.

Much Experience is the category for a score ranging from 60% to 79%. Typically, a student in this category would require a thorough review before moving on to the next level.

Some Experience reflects a score of 59% and below. Since there is such a wide disparity in this category, parents should use their discretion when deciding whether or not the student can move on to the next level following a thorough review.

No Experience indicates that the student has not learned the material.

The test begins with the most basic Latin grammar and becomes increasingly more difficult; therefore, students may only be able to answer the first few pages. Once students are unable to even guess at answers, they should stop answering and the test should be graded.

The test is divided into three sections, each of which should be graded individually with the intent of assessing whether or not a student can "test out" of that section. Ultimately, however, the decision is up to the parents and students. The results may be somewhat subjective, for example, **Mastery** of the Part Two section (Second Form) combined with **Some Experience** of Part Three (Third Form) section could indicate a student who is prepared for **Third Form Latin** but will also have to endure some review. Again, this test only serves as a guide in making the decision about Latin curriculum placement. Finally, determination and work ethic will prove more valuable for the success of Latin students no matter the level they begin this year.
